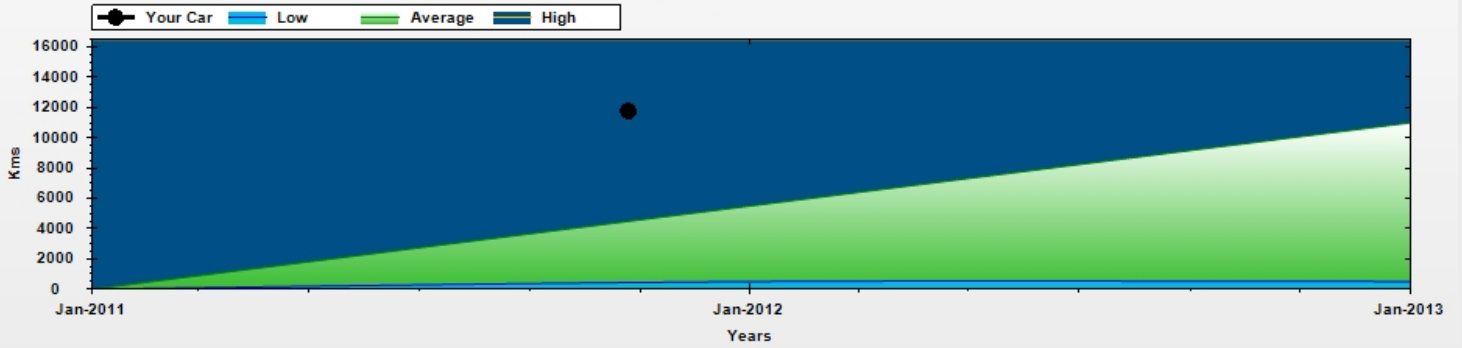

v glossary

Base record - the first available record.

Cancellation - refers to either automatic or voluntary cancellation.

- automatic cancellation occurs when a registration payment is not received within 60 days of the expiry date or is not received for some other acceptable reason.

- voluntary cancellation of registration is at the registered operator's request, the request may be as a result of the vehicle: being for sale, stolen or destroyed, registered interstate, no longer used on roads, involved in an accident.

Colour - is the exterior paint of a vehicle, a vehicle can have two colours; primary which is the more predominant colour and secondary, which is the less predominant colour.

Engine number - identifies the motor of a motor vehicle/bike and is any combination of letters/numbers and may vary in length.

Exempt written-off inspection - Transport and Main Roads has deemed that the damage sustained by a vehicle is not sufficient to warrant a written-off vehicle inspection.

History transactions - shows the date the transaction was recorded in Transport and Main Roads registration system.

New business - refers to registering a vehicle in Queensland that is: currently unregistered, registered interstate or is a new vehicle

Transfer - a change of registered operator (that is, the person responsible for the operation of the vehicle).

Pass written-off inspection - an inspection has been completed for a vehicle which was previously classified as a repairable write off.

Plate transfer - this indicates that new plates have been issued due to the original plates being lost, damaged, stolen or that customised / personalised plates have been removed / attached.

Police report reference number - the reference number identifying the stolen vehicle report.

Repairable write-off - a vehicle that has been assessed as uneconomical to repair. The vehicle will only be re-registered if it is repaired and passes a written-off vehicle inspection and Safety Certificate inspection.

REVS / Security Interest Certificate - The register of security interests (otherwise known as REVS) provides access to a database of vehicles that have money owing on them.

When a bank, finance company or individual takes out an interest in a vehicle (that is, provides a loan to the owner) they register their interest in the vehicle with the Department of Employment, Economic Development and Innovation.

Statutory write-off - a vehicle that is too badly damaged to be repaired to a standard that is safe for road use, therefore it is suitable only for use as parts or scrap. The vehicle will not be allowed to be registered.

Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) - a unique alpha numeric combination of 17 characters assigned to a vehicle. It does not contain the letters I, O or Q.

Written-off date - the date the vehicle was assessed as a write-off.

Written-off vehicles - those vehicles which have been in an accident, or suffered some form of water, fire or malicious damage. Written-off vehicles are classified as either a statutory or repairable write-off.

NSW Written-Off Vehicle Pass - a vehicle showing a NSW written-off vehicle inspection pass may require further inspection before being eligible for registration. For QLD registration contact Transport and Main Roads 13 23 80. For other states and territories, contact the relevant jurisdiction.

Written-off vehicle damage details:

Dismantled - a statutory write-off that is stripped of interior and exterior body parts, panels and components.

Fire damage - sections or all of the vehicle has been burnt by fire.

Hail damage - sections or all of the vehicle has been damaged by hail.

Impact damage - damage caused, due to violent contact with another object.

Malicious damage - wilful damage or destruction of a vehicle.

Refer jurisdiction - contact the relevant registration authority.

Unrecovered theft - a stolen vehicle that has not been recovered - contact the relevant registration authority.

Water damage* - immersed in fresh or salt water.

* If the report indicates that the vehicle has been water damaged it is recommended that an independent inspection is obtained from a qualified person such as a mechanic or an auto electrician.

Under current Transport and Main Roads (TMR) legislation, TMR is unable to release details of the severity and location of write-off damage.

Terminology	Definition
Air Pollution Rating	The Air Pollution Rating is based on the level of air pollutant emissions allowable under the standard to which the particular vehicle has been successfully tested to for supply to the Australian market.
ANCAP Safety Rating	The Australasian New Car Assessment Program (ANCAP) gives consumers consistent information on the level of occupant protection provided by vehicles in serious front and side crashes. The score is a star rating, between 1 to 5 stars. The higher scores are awarded more stars.
Body	A vehicle's body type.
Cylinders/Rotors	Engine cylinder configuration.
Dealer Price	An indicative vehicle value for non-franchise dealer trade or wholesale transactions. Trade low must be adjusted for (Back 10 Years) kilometres and condition. Please refer to the 'Guide Condition' definition.
Dealer Trade Price	A median value achieved by a franchise dealer, e.g. Ford dealer would achieve for a Ford, (Back 10 Years) for a vehicle in 'Guide Condition' and average kilometres. Please refer to the 'Guide Condition'.
